KEY TO SECONDARY SCHOOL - ORGANISATION!

Organisation/ Responsibility

- Learn locker combination and get the correct materials before each class.
- Know their timetable and know where to go for each class.
- Keep up to date with work and assessments across up to 9 subjects at a time - regularly use school diary and compass
- Speak up to teachers and ask questions if unsure
- Parents keep up to date with students day to day Excursions, assessments, absences, communication with teachers etc



EXTENSION AND HIGH ABILITIES PROGRAMS

Victorian High Abilities Program is an initiative run by DET.

Students are selected based on their NAPLAN results and teacher judgement.

Students can participate in online masterclasses in either English or Maths once a week.

Accelerate Program is an extra-curricular club run by teachers before/after school. Students must be apply to participate and will be selected based on expression of interest and endorsement from teachers.

ICAS is an external assessment that students can nominate to participate in. Information will be shared with our school community closer to the date (Term 3).





YEAR 7 ENGAGEMENT - HOUSE STRUCTURE

• From 2023 Years 7-9 operate on a house structure

- Davis, Cowie, Hogans, Morris
- 3 classes per house
- Support Structure (across 7-9)
 - Assistant Principal (oversees 2 houses)
 - House Leader
 - House Mentors (2 per house)
 - Homeroom Teacher
- Allow students to develop strong relationships with staff over their 3 years of secondary school at TP9C



HOUSE STRUCTURE - CONNECTION

Each morning 8.50am Homeroom - Check in with Homeroom Teacher.

• This will be the same person over Year 7-9 and will be the first point of contact for students and families

Houses will hold regular assemblies

- Share important information and events
- Celebrate and reward student achievement

Houses will hold inter and intra house events

- A range of sporting, arts, cultural and extra curricular activities will be held through houses to enhance students experiences at school
- Student leadership to help run various events


COMPASS APP
